Calvary Chapel Lakeside Statement of Faith

We believe the whole Bible to be the inspired, inerrant Word of God, (authoritative for daily life) without error in the original writings.

We believe that salvation is the gift of God brought to man by grace and received by personal trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. Those who have so trusted Christ are indwelt by the Holy Spirit and enabled to live a Godly life through submission to Him.

We believe that the Holy Spirit is a person. He is God and possesses all the divine attributes. He indwells all Believers, baptizes, imparts gifts (charismata) as He wills.

We believe unconfessed sin and unrepented hearts brings interruption in fellowship with God, bringing the loving discipline of the Heavenly Father.

Food For Thought

Revisited

With Pastor Bill

How can you tell that God has changed your life? Galatians chapter five gives us a list of deeds we can recognize so that we may know God is working in us. If we have an abundance of "love joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control" we can receive great assurance that Christ is working in us. If we practice "sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft, hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies and the like" it is clear the Spirit of God is not influencing us in the right direction. At this point we would do well to look at 2 Corinthians 13:5, "Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you-- unless, of course, you fail the test?" (NIV). Something to think about...
