Calvary Chapel Lakeside **Statement of Faith**

We believe that all men are sinners by nature and by practice, being alienated from God; man is unable to remedy his lost condition in and of himself.

We believe that salvation is the gift of God brought to man by grace and received by personal trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. Those who have so trusted Christ are indwelt by the Holy Spirit and enabled to live a Godly life through submission to Him.

We believe that the Holy Spirit is a person. He is God and possesses all the divine attributes. He indwells all Believers, baptizes, imparts gifts (charismata) as He wills.

We believe unconfessed sin and unrepented hearts brings interruption in fellowship with God, bringing the loving discipline of the Heavenly Father.

Food For Thought

Revisited

Do you struggle with thoughts popping into your head that shouldn't be there? Do you dwell on those things or fight to rid it from your mind? A pure thought life is integral to living a holy life. Proverbs 4:23 says, "Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it." The heart in this verse refers to the thoughts of the inner man and shows that, whether good or evil, unchecked thoughts can turn into actions. We cannot dwell on evil and reap good in our life, so it is important not to let the mind wander aimlessly, but to "take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5). For the thought life to be obedient to Christ our mind must be "renewed" in the knowledge of God's word (Col. 3:10), and only then will our actions be transformed to that "good, pleasing and perfect will of God" (Romans 12:2).
