Skyscrapers built in honor of their owners will eventually be sold or torn down and with it their names. Even the men listed on the wonderful Declaration of Independence are all but forgotten by most Americans. When there is a new heaven and a new earth the scripture tells us, "...The former things will not be remembered, nor will they come to mind. Isa 65:17 (NIV) This begs the question, "What then should we pursue in this life?" Again, Solomon has the answer. Eccl 12:13 "...
