Calvary Chapel Lakeside Statement of Faith


We believe unconfessed sin and unrepented hearts brings interruption in fellowship with God, bringing the loving discipline of the Heavenly Father.

Food For Thought

Revisited

Do you struggle with thoughts popping into your head that shouldn't be there? Do you dwell on those things or fight to rid it from your mind? Have you been hurt and found it hard to forgive the offense? While it's often said, "I can forgive, but I can't forget", remembering someone's sin does not mean it can be held against them. The term forgiveness comes from the Greek word *aphiemi*, which means "to let go, to give up, to keep no longer." The idea is that of debt being erased from the record, and the documents listing the debt being shredded. Matthew 6:14-15 shows us that forgiveness is required of those who have been forgiven and that a failure to do so will damage our relationship with God. Forgiveness becomes an easier task when we realize the sins committed against us are trivial compared to the enormity of our sins against God. Ephesians 4:32 tells us, "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Forgiveness then is not an occasional act, it is a permanent attitude.
