Calvary Chapel Lakeside Statement of Faith

We believe that salvation is the gift of God brought to man by grace and received by personal trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. Those who have so trusted Christ are indwelt by the Holy Spirit and enabled to live a Godly life through submission to Him.

We believe that the Holy Spirit is a person. He is God and possesses all the divine attributes. He indwells all Believers, baptizes, imparts gifts (charismata) as He wills.

We believe unconfessed sin and unrepented hearts brings interruption in fellowship with God, bringing the loving discipline of the Heavenly Father.

We believe in the church of Jesus Christ as the Body of True Believers Universal, called out by the Holy Spirit, espoused to be the Bride of Christ.

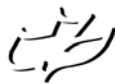
We believe in the personal, imminent, and pre-millennial return of Jesus Christ to establish His Kingdom.

Food For Thought

Prayer, an essential part of our Christian faith, is mentioned as one of four things done by the early church in the book of Acts that contributed to the growth of the church (Acts 2:42). Paul, knowing this was consistently praying for, and asking for prayer for the cities he would minister in. In 2 Thessalonians 3:1 he asks, "that the word of the Lord may have free course and be glorified," and again in Col. 4:3 "praying also for us, that God would open to us a door for the word." We see the effects of these prayers when Paul states in another place, "For a great and effective door has opened to me" (1 Cor. 16:9). It is necessary then that as Epaphras we are "always laboring fervently... in prayers" to open doors for the word, not just for our missionary brethren overseas, but also for God to set up those Divine gospel appointments in our own lives.
