baptizes, imparts gifts (charismata) as He wills.

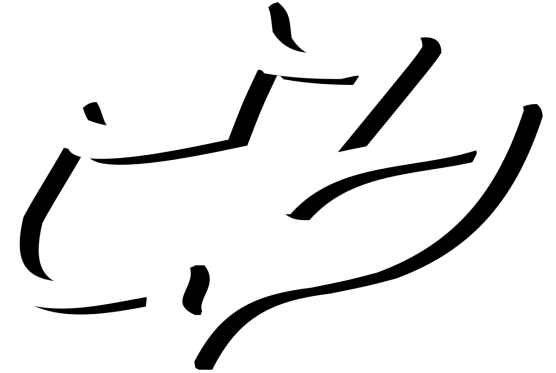
We believe unconfessed sin and unrepented hearts brings

be the Bride of Christ.

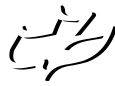
We believe in the personal, imminent, and pre-millennial return

Revisited

During our country's financial crisis it is difficult to know what to do, but God has given us counsel for just such occasions. If we lack wisdom we are to ask God and he will give it 'generously to all without finding fault' James 1:5 NIV. We are not to worry about what is in store for the future once we have asked for the Lord's help. Matthew 6:34 states "Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself.
