Statement of Faith

be the Bride of Christ.

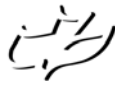
We believe in the personal, imminent, and pre-millennial return

Revisited

With Pastor Bill

Has anyone ever been such a burden to you that you grumble or groan? Do you sigh when they call or when you see them in person do you avoid talking to them? God would not have us act in such a fashion. Instead, we are to consider others better than ourselves even in the face of adversity. James 5:9 says, "Don't grumble against each other, brothers, or you will be judged. The Judge is standing at the door!" (NIV). To hold a grudge or believe that someone is bringing you grief places us in a position of judgment. Whenever these feelings are expressed to another individual, we are not following the command to only let wholesome words be spoken.
