Statement of Faith

We believe that all men are sinners by nature and by practice, being alienated from God; man is unable to remedy his lost condition in and of himself.

We believe that salvation is the gift of God brought to man by grace and received by personal trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. Those who have so trusted Christ are indwelt by the Holy Spirit and enabled to live a Godly life through submission to Him.

We believe that the Holy Spirit is a person. He is God and possesses all the divine attributes. He indwells all Believers, baptizes, imparts gifts (charismata) as He wills.

We believe unconfessed sin and unrepented hearts brings interruption in fellowship with God, bringing the loving discipline of the Heavenly Father.

We believe in the church of Jesus Christ as the Body of True Believers Universal, called out by the Holy Spirit, espoused to be the Bride of Christ.

Food For Thought

Revisited

As believers we have a tendency to focus blame on others for trials we encounter. Another person, or so it seems, often appears to be at the root of our discontent. The Bible tells us that struggles such as these have their origins in the spiritual realm. It is written in Eph 6:12, "For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms." (NIV). When we begin to recognize the source of our trials as being in the spiritual realm it provides for us a new perspective. Instead of focusing blame on others it should cause us to pray for our earthly adversaries and ask the Lord to intercede in the spiritual realm. Having this outlook will reduce stress in relationships and cultivate trust in God as He provides further wisdom to battle the enemy and his schemes. Something to think about...
