of Jesus Christ to establish His Kingdom.

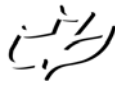
We believe in the bodily resurrection of both the saved and the

**Revisited**

**With Pastor Bill**

Work is an activity that has been ordained by God. Those who intentionally seek to avoid it are to be shunned when they are able to perform. 1 Timothy 5:8 states, "If anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for his immediate family, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever." (NIV) and in 1 Thessalonians 4:11 we are told, "Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business and to work with your hands, just as we told you," (NIV). Scripture goes so far as to say, "...If a man will not work, he shall not eat." (II Thessalonians 3:10, NIV). Many people fall into difficult times when they lose their jobs.
