**Statement of Faith**

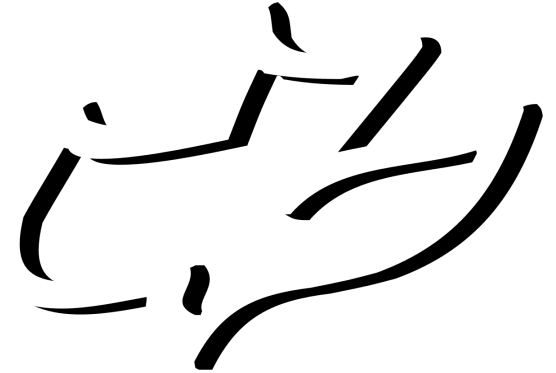
We believe unconfessed sin and unrepented hearts brings interruption in fellowship with God, bringing the loving discipline of the Heavenly Father.

We believe in the church of Jesus Christ as the Body of True Believers Universal, called out by the Holy Spirit, espoused to be the Bride of Christ.

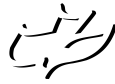
We believe in the personal, imminent, and pre-millennial return of Jesus Christ to establish His Kingdom.

In our culture the tendency is to spend an entire life getting ready to retire. Storing up wealth so that when are old we can possess a life of ease. Although there is nothing wrong with having a comfortable retirement what we should be careful of is what we store up. Scripture tells us what we should accumulate in addition to wealth. It is written in Proverbs 16:16 "How much better to get wisdom than gold, to choose understanding rather than silver!" (NIV). Also in Proverbs 4:7 we are told, "Wisdom is supreme; therefore get wisdom. Though it cost all you have, get understanding."(NIV). Wisdom and understanding therefore are to be increased just as a bank account.
